**SUMMARY**



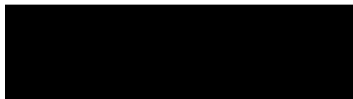
