Esq., and Zachary Karmen, Esq. having appeared as Attorney for the Child, and the Petitioner having
requested an order of custody for the child [REDACTED]; and due
deliberation having been had,

AND, the Court having searched the Statewide Registry of Order of Protection, the Sex
Offender Registry, Family Court and Child Protective decisions, and Family Court warrants of arrest

for each of the parties and the child; and the Court having fully considered the results of those searches and having notified the parties of such findings *and having concluded that the results do not impact the parties, nor the relief requested herein - JF*

NOW, upon the motion of Amanda Lynn Cortese, Esq., Attorney for the Petitioner, it is hereby


ORDERED, that the parties shall share joint legal custody of the child, and the Petitioner-Mother shall have primary physical custody of the child; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Respondent-Father shall have parenting time with the child as follows:

1. Each and every Tuesday, from 1:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m.;
2. Each and every Friday, from 1:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m.;
3. Each and every Sunday, from 10:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.;
4. One overnight per week, from 6:00 p.m. until 12:00 p.m. the following day, on the day of the week as mutually agreed by the parties;
5. All such parenting time shall occur at either the home of the Respondent-Father or the home of the Petitioner-Mother;
6. All transportation to effectuate such parenting time shall be done as the parties mutually agree;
7. All holidays and birthdays shall be shared and/or alternated as the parties mutually agree.
